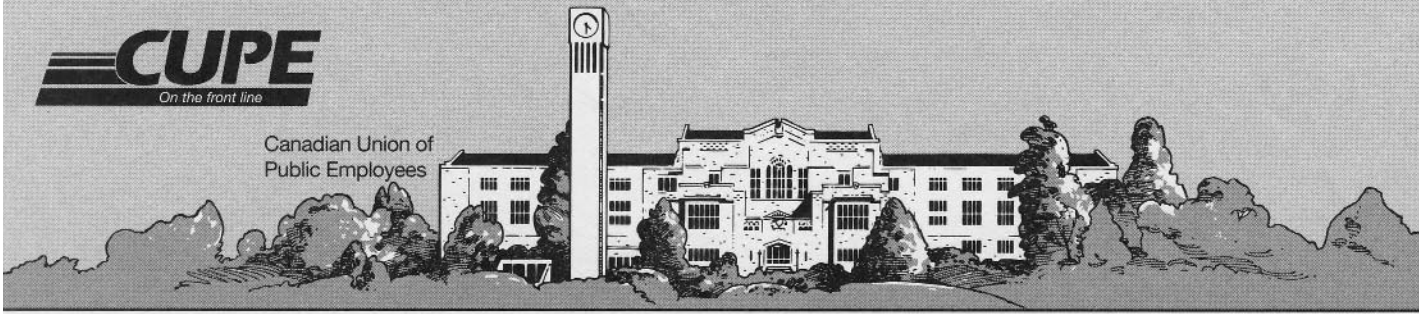

Maintaining and growing the protections and benefits provided by our Collective Agreement at Bargaining is Gregg's driving goal.

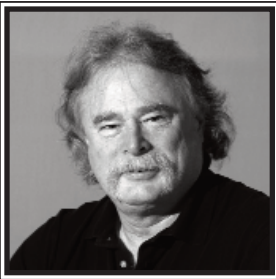
