Your CUPE 116 Aquatic Centre Bargaining Committee met with the University on Thursday, November 17th to recommence negotiations at the bargaining table.

The Employer came prepared to present a number of responses to proposals that the Union had previously tabled, and appeared committed to ensuring that there was a productive exchange of dialogue between the Parties.

We were able to enter into an agreement on a number of substantive issues such as language that will support an effective and functional Health and Safety Committee in the workplace, as well as new language that provides the Union with the opportunity to host an orientation meeting for all newly-hired employees.

It is our hope that the Parties will be able to sustain a cooperative approach as we continue to bargain and pursue a fair and enhanced collective agreement.

We will continue to update the membership as we proceed through bargaining.
